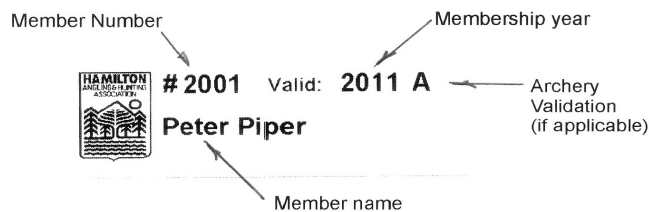


Notice to go out with the November meeting notice:

We are trying out a major revision to our membership cards in the hope of streamlining things for our members and our membership secretary.

Instead of issuing a new card each year we plan to issue a permanent card - with a 4-digit club number which will not change from year to year. The card will note it is valid for 2011. In future years when you renew you will receive a smaller sticker with just the year (e.g. 2012) on it and you will put this on your main card. (Something like auto license plate renewals.) Archers note: until we get a card reader set up on the archery course cards that are valid for archery will have an A following the year. (2011 A, e.g.)

The main sticker will be approximately 1" x 3" and will look somewhat as below:



Renewals: if we have a record of your having received a gate swipe card we will send you a main sticker with the intention that you should apply it to the swipe card, which will then act as membership card, gate opening card, and range access card.

If you do not have a swipe card we will send you a more conventional permanent card with the sticker attached.

New memberships: in general these will be provided with the "conventional permanent card" - if the member later gets a swipe card and wishes a sticker for it, it will not be difficult to make one up.

The stickers are very durable, but if one gets damaged or lost it will not be difficult for us to make a replacement - perhaps for a nominal fee.

Notice to go out with the stickers:

Our records show you have a swipe card for access to the club. The enclosed sticker should be applied to the top surface of the swipe card - see below.

In future years you will receive a smaller updating sticker with just the year - this can be placed anywhere in the open area of the swipe card.
